rifty-nine photographs by 53 photographers are included in a comprehensive exhibition of Recent Acquisitions at the Museum of Modern Art, New York, December 21 - February 12, 1961. The photographs will be shown along with paintings, sculptures, prints, drawings, architecture models, design objects, posters, and movie stills.

Acquired for the Museum's collection on the basis of excellence, the photographs in the show, in both color and black and white, were taken within the last decade. Styles vary from photo-journalism to abstraction. Photographers represented, all living, are of nine nationalities - American, Austrian, English, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Swedish and Swiss. They range in age from Man Ray, born 1890, to 22-year-old Key L. Nilson. Among those who have not exhibited at the Museum before are Monika von Boch, John Brook, Suzanne Hausammann, George Krause, and Jack Smith. Well-known photographers include Shirley C. Burden, Roy DeCarava, Robert Frank, Ernst Haas, and Frederick Sommer.

Also in the exhibition are paintings by Cézanne, Degas, Monet, Picasso, Seurat and Toulouse-Lautrec; etchings, lithographs and woodcuts by American, Eskimo, European and Japanese artists; drawings, among them a famous Miro; an architectural model by Mies van der Rohe; furniture by Le Corbusier, Aalto and Eames; the Joseph H. Heil collection of Tiffany glass; American and European posters; and an assortment of stills taken from films newly acquired by the Museum's Film Library.

The photography collection, now comprising 3,000 works, is formed by the approval of an Acquisitions Committee upon recommendation of the Department.
