In conjunction with SOL LEWITT, a retrospective exhibition of the work of one of the major artists of the last decade, The Museum of Modern Art is presenting a series of lectures and gallery talks to elucidate the various aspects of LeWitt's influential yet sometimes difficult work.

Sol LeWitt himself will lecture and discuss his work in a program especially for students and teachers on Saturday, February 11 at 10:00 a.m. Tickets are free and can be obtained at the Lobby Information Desk. Ticket-holders will be invited to view the exhibition after the program.
