Thomas Benton, the well known painter, will speak on American Folk Art on Thursday, December 15th, at 8:30 p.m. at the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53d Street, where the Exhibition of "The Art of the Common Man" will continue on display until January 15th, 1933.

The talk will be supplemented by folk singing, by Miss Edna Thomas and Gale Huntington. Holger Cahill, Director of the Exhibition, will introduce Mr. Benton and the singers.

Arrangements for the lecture and folk songs have been made by the Education Committee of the Museum, of which Mrs. W. Murray Crane of New York is Chairman.

Tickets are on sale to the public at the Museum. Members of the Museum are admitted free.
